The Council on Standards for International Educational Travel (CSIET) has found Northeast Student Consulting LLC to have fulfilled all the requirements for CSIET Listing and grants your organization a **Full F-1 Inbound Listing** for the *2018-2019 Advisory List of International Educational Travel and Exchange Programs*.

Recall that for the *2018-2019 Advisory List of International and Educational Travel & Exchange Programs*, there are four separate listing categories. The listing categories are as follows:

- Inbound J-1 Programs
- Inbound F-1 Programs
- Outbound Programs
- Short-term Programs (Inbound and Outbound)

*CSIET listing entitles an organization to publicize the fact that its program is conducted in accordance with the published standards. Further, listed organizations are entitled to use the CSIET certification mark during the period it is listed in the publication in accordance with CSIET policy (see “CSIET Trademark Policy” document).

*CSIET listing does not entitle an organization to paid promotional opportunities (Weblinks, Direct Connect, Flyers, Stickers, etc). These promotional opportunities will be available for purchase at the end of March 2018. Your organization will then receive a specific communication about promotional opportunities from our Director of Marketing & Communications, Charissa Slack. Promotional opportunities purchased last year will remain active on our websites through May 3, 2018. Newly purchased promotions will become active on May 4, 2018.

2017-18 Review Process

F-1, Outbound and Short-Term Programs were judged based on the following criteria:

Requirement A: Programs must score an overall average minimum of 85% or better for all audit questions.

AND

Requirement B: Programs must score an 85% or better on each of the following critical program issues:

- High School Enrollment

- Host Family Screening - application, CBC, interviews, references
- Monthly Contact
- Staff/Volunteer Screening, CBC

AND

Requirement C: Programs must score a minimum of 75% or above on each individual audit question.

*Newly applied F-1, Outbound and Short-Term organizations must score a minimum of 85% or above on each individual audit question. Upon demonstration of this level of compliance, new organizations are issued a Provisional Listing. Provisionally listed organizations must demonstrate 85% or better compliance for a period of two evaluation cycles in order to be eligible for a Full Listing status. Provisionally listed organizations can reduce this period to one evaluation cycle by attending the required training sessions at the CSIET Annual Conference. Please contact CSIET for more information.
